Professional and business services led the year-over job figures

The unemployment rate in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD was 3.2 percent in October 2016, unchanged from a revised 3.2 percent in September 2016, and below the year-ago estimate of 3.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 4.7 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 3.4 percent in San Francisco County, and 3.1 percent in San Mateo County.

Between September 2016 and October 2016, the total number of jobs in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD, which includes the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo, increased by 8,700 jobs to total 1,101,300.


- Leisure and hospitality expanded by 2,900 jobs. This major industry group experienced no change on average between September and October over the prior ten years.
- Private educational and health services gained 2,300 jobs. Educational services (up 1,500 jobs) accounted for nearly two-thirds of the gain.
- Government added 1,900 jobs, with most of the gain in local and state government educational services.
- Financial activities increased by 900 jobs, atypical of its 10-year average decline this time of year.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities grew by 800 jobs, mostly in retail trade (up 600 jobs).

Between October 2015 and October 2016, the total number of jobs in the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo increased by 26,200, or 2.4 percent.

- Professional and business service led the year-over increase with an expansion of 10,600 jobs.
- Private educational and health services added 5,700 jobs. Health care (up 2,700 jobs) accounted for nearly half of the gain.
- Leisure and hospitality experienced a net gain of 3,600 jobs.
- The trade, transportation, and utilities sector and the construction sector surged by 2,400 jobs each.
- Government netted a 2,300-job gain, and financial activities rose by 1,500 jobs.
- Meanwhile, other services (such as automotive repair and maintenance, personal and laundry services, and membership organizations and associations) decreased by 1,200 jobs.
