# Industry Cluster Methodology


- An industry cluster describes a specific grouping of companies with related business activities.
- These businesses are economically interdependent and may have common supply chains, labor needs, technologies, and economic markets.
- Data is derived from Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages. Provides the number of businesses, jobs, and total payroll for workers covered by unemployment insurance programs.




# Capitol Region

  - **Yolo County Workforce Innovation Board:** Yolo County


# Capitol Region Industry Clusters of Opportunity 2010-2015




# Golden Sierra Industry Cluster Study 2010-2015




# North Central Counties Consortium Industry Clusters of Opportunity 2010-2015
