












Nonfarm Jobs Among California Areas

September 2010 (Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)




County Unemployment Rates

September 2010 (Not Seasonally Adjusted)




Year Over Change in County Unemployment Rates



Job Changes in California Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) and Metropolitan Divisions (MDs) in the Current Business Cycle





