

Demographic Profiles for Local Workforce Investment Areas in California (2000 Census of Population and Housing)

The U.S. Census Bureau has released a series of **Demographic Profiles** for the 2000 Census of Population and Housing. These four-page profiles contain summary data for age, race/ethnicity, sex, household type and relationship, housing occupancy, and the social and economic data, such as income, poverty and labor force. The Profiles were released for California, counties, incorporated cities and Census Designated Places, Congressional Districts, and Indian Reservations.

Selected **Local Workforce Investment Areas** (LWIA) in California consist of a group of legal jurisdictions rather than a single county or city. In response to their request, the following Demographic Profile was generated from the Demographic Profiles for the individual component geography.

Missing Data Items:

Since the detailed data needed to calculate some elements are not available on the Profile itself, these items are not present in these “aggregate” Profiles. “N/A” in the “Number” column indicates these items.

Calculated Medians:

It was necessary to calculate median values from the data available in ranges. The following medians were calculated: Age; Household and Family Income; Number of Rooms; Value; Selected Monthly Owner Costs (with a mortgage); and Gross Rent. They are indicated with “[CALCULATED]” in the item description.

The user should be aware that the difference of these medians from the actual median is in direct relationship to the width of the ranges from which they are calculated. For example, the median age will be more accurate since the ranges are only 5 or 10 years compared to the median household income where the ranges are \$10,000 or \$25,000 in width.
