

**SAN DIEGO-CARLSBAD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA
(SAN DIEGO COUNTY)**

Nonfarm employment up 8,900 jobs over the month; up 29,500 jobs over the year

The unemployment rate in the San Diego County was 4.8 percent in October 2016, up from a revised 4.7 percent in September 2016, and below the year-ago estimate of 5.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 4.7 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between September 2016 and October 2016, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,422,800 to 1,431,700, a gain of 8,900 jobs. Agricultural employment decreased by 300 jobs, or 3.3 percent.


- The largest over-the-month increase was reported in government (up 6,700 jobs). Employment growth was bolstered in large part by seasonal gains in local government education (up 3,300 jobs), and state government education (up 3,100 jobs), as classes continued to resume following summer breaks.
- Educational and health services added 2,400 jobs, led by advances in educational services (up 1,700 jobs).
- Trade, transportation and utilities grew by 2,000 jobs. Retail trade added 2,500 jobs, with losses in transportation and warehousing being offset by most other sectors. Wholesale trade employment fell by 100 jobs.
- Other industries reporting payroll employment growth included construction (up 1,900 jobs), financial activities (up 1,100 jobs), and other services (up 700 jobs).
- Leisure and hospitality noted the largest overall employment decrease (down 5,300 jobs), as the summer tourist season came to a close.

Between October 2015 and October 2016, total nonfarm employment increased by 29,500 jobs, or 2.1 percent. Agricultural employment declined by 400 jobs, or 4.3 percent.

- Educational and health services recorded the largest year-over gain with the addition of 6,400 jobs. Healthcare and social assistance accounted for over 87 percent of the increase (up 5,600 jobs), while educational services contributed 800 jobs to the growth.
- Government employment grew by 6,200 jobs, led by advances in local government (up 4,100 jobs).
- Other sectors with over-the-year job gains included leisure and hospitality (up 5,300 jobs), professional and business services (up 5,000 jobs), construction (up 1,900 jobs), financial activities (up 1,800 jobs), trade, transportation and utilities (up 1,300 jobs), other services (up 1,300 jobs), and information (up 300 jobs).
