Educational and health services lead employment gains both month-over and year-over

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Los Angeles County increased over the month to 5.1 percent in October 2016, from a revised 5.0 percent in September 2016, and was below the rate of 6.1 one year ago. Civilian employment increased by 20,000 to 4,882,000 in October 2016, while unemployment increased by 6,000 to 263,000 over the month. The civilian labor force increased by 25,000 over the month to 5,144,000 in October 2016. (All of the above figures are seasonally adjusted.) The unadjusted unemployment rate for the county was 5.1 percent in October 2016.

The California seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.5 percent in October 2016, 5.5 percent in September 2016, and 5.9 percent a year ago in October 2015. The comparable estimates for the nation were 4.9 percent in October 2016, 5.0 percent in September 2016, and 5.0 percent a year ago.

Between September 2016 and October 2016, Los Angeles County total nonfarm employment increased by 38,900 jobs to reach 4,400,800.

- Educational and health services posted the largest month-over employment increase (up 14,600). Gains in both educational services (up 7,700) and health care and social assistance (up 6,900), accounted for the growth. Government reported the second largest employment gain over the month (up 11,500). Expansions in local government (up 7,300), and state government (up 4,300), offset a loss in federal government (down 100).
- Trade, transportation, and utilities also reported payroll increases of 6,000 jobs, with retail trade (up 6,500) and wholesale trade (up 2,400), accounting for the surge. Transportation and warehousing declined by 2,900 jobs.
- Other industries posting month-over payroll gains were information (up 4,500), professional and business services (up 2,900), other services (up 1,300), and leisure and hospitality (up 200).
- Construction posted the largest month-over decline by dropping 1,000 jobs. Other industries posting over the month declines were manufacturing (down 1,000), and financial activities (down 100). Mining and logging remained unchanged.

Between October 2015 and October 2016, total nonfarm employment in Los Angeles County increased by 71,200 jobs, or 1.6 percent.

- The largest year-over payroll increase was in educational and health services (up 25,100). Health care and social assistance accounted for 87 percent of the growth with an addition of 21,800 jobs. Leisure and hospitality posted the second largest employment gain (up 13,400). Accommodation and food services led the expansion with an addition of 11,700 jobs.
- Government added 9,600 jobs over the year. Government expansion was led by local government adding 7,300 jobs, followed by state government with 1,900 jobs, and

federal government adding 400 jobs. Other industries posting year-over increases were professional and business services (up 9,200), trade, transportation, and utilities (up 9,000), information (up 5,300), financial activities (up 5,300), and other services (up 3,000).

- Manufacturing posted the largest year-over employment decline (down 6,000). Its employment losses were divided between durable goods (down 3,200), and nondurable goods (down 2,800).
- Other industries posting over the year declines were construction (down 2,100), and mining and logging (down 600).
