The unemployment rate in the Napa County was 3.8 percent in October 2016, unchanged from a revised 3.8 percent in September 2016, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 4.7 percent for the nation during the same period.
