

**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**

**Nonfarm jobs up 13,600 over the month; up 24,600 over the year**

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 6.1 percent in October 2016, down from a revised 6.2 percent in September 2016, and below the year-ago estimate of 6.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 4.7 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 6.3 percent in Riverside County, and 5.8 percent in San Bernardino County.

**Between September 2016 and October 2016**, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,380,600 to 1,394,200, a gain of 13,600 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 500 jobs.


- Government posted the largest month-over employment increase, adding 8,500 jobs. Employment gains were reported in local government (up 6,600), and state government (up 1,900). Federal government remained unchanged over the month.
- An increase of 2,200 jobs was reported in educational and health services. The job growth was split evenly between educational services and healthcare and social assistance (up 1,100 each).
- Other notable job additions were reported in trade, transportation, and utilities (up 1,400), financial activities (up 900), construction (up 700), leisure and hospitality (up 400), other services (up 300), and manufacturing (up 200). Information and mining and logging registered no change over the month.
- Professional and business services reported the only month-over decline, down 1,000 jobs. The professional, scientific, and technical services sector and the administrative and support and waste services sector lost 500 jobs each. Management of companies and enterprises noted no change over the month.

**Between October 2015 and October 2016**, total nonfarm employment increased by 24,600 jobs or 1.8 percent. Agricultural employment remained unchanged.

- Government registered the largest year-over increase, up 10,300 jobs. Local government and state government added 8,400 and 1,600 jobs respectively. Federal government increased by 300 jobs over the year.
- Six of ten remaining super sectors recorded payroll gains over the year. The majority of the job additions were noted in trade, transportation, and utilities (up 7,000), educational and health services (up 5,900), and manufacturing (up 2,220).
- Job losses were recorded in professional and business services (down 1,900), leisure and hospitality (down 1,300), financial activities (down 200), and mining and logging (down 200).

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 6.1 percent in October 2016, down from a revised 6.2 percent in September 2016, and below the year-ago estimate of 6.4 percent.
