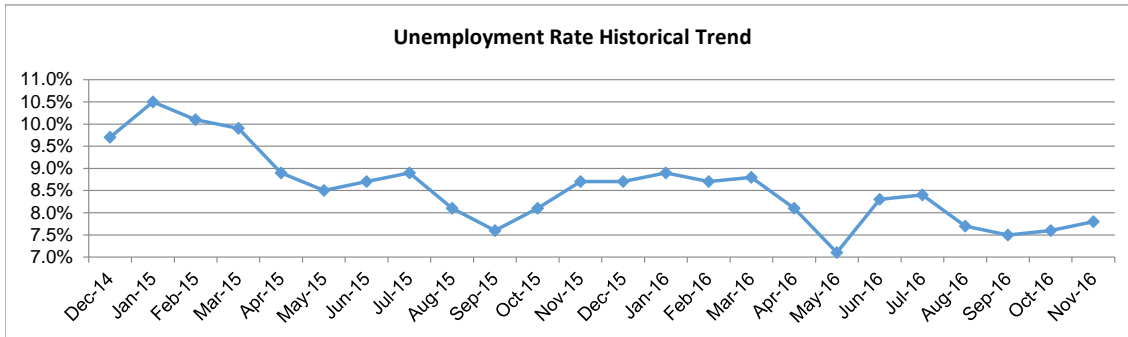


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 STOCKTON-LODI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (San Joaquin County)

The unemployment rate in the San Joaquin County was 7.8 percent in November 2016, up from a revised 7.6 percent in October 2016, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.0 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
