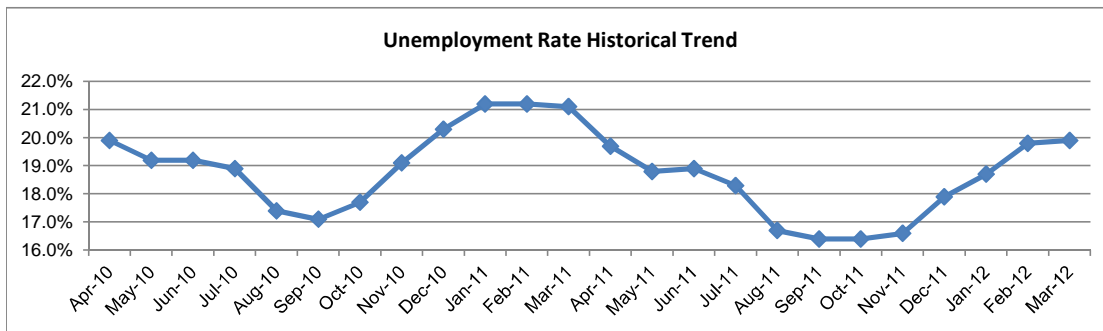


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 YUBA CITY METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Sutter and Yuba Counties)

The unemployment rate in the Yuba City MSA was 19.9 percent in March 2012, up from a revised 19.8 percent in February 2012, but below the year-ago estimate of 21.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 11.5 percent for California and 8.4 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 21.0 percent in Sutter County, and 18.3 percent in Yuba County.
